

VILLAGE OF MERVIN

BYLAW NO. 53

Mervin, Sask.

WITH RESPECT TO LIVE STOCK AND POULTRY

The council of the village of Mervin in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall herd cattle at any time within the limits of the village.

2. No person shall graze cattle, nor shall any cattle be permitted to graze at any time within,

(a) the limits of the village

3. No person shall keep horses, cattle, or other live stock, poultry, pigeons, foxes, mink, rabbits or any other animals reared for the bearing of fur, or any of them,

(a) within the limits of the village

Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the village.
